

School Dental Screening



During the school year, a Health Educator or a Dental Hygienist will conduct a dental screening for all students daycare to Grade 8. This involves a quick look in the mouth with sterilized dental instruments and/or a flashlight.

The screenings are designed to provide information for planning the school dental health program, measure the effects of water fluoridation, build a positive dental attitude in children and identify and follow-up children who have urgent dental needs.

If screened by the Dental Hygienist your child will be given a notification card to take home. If urgent dental treatment is required, an application form for financial assistance will be mailed to you.
