Re: Domestic Travel Recommendations

At this time, Northwestern Health Unit (NWHU) strongly recommends that residents do not travel outside of the community that they live in, unless for essential purposes.

Individuals who travel outside of their community should <u>self-monitor</u> for 14 days, and <u>self-isolate</u> if symptoms develop. Anyone with symptoms can and should get tested for COVID-19. For more information about testing, the public can call NWHU's COVID-19 hotline at 1-866-468-2240.

People who decide to travel outside of their community are reminded to practice personal protective measures, including physical distancing and hand hygiene throughout their time away from home.
