COVID-19 Cases Update

As of this morning, there are 3 active cases of COVID-19 in the region. Low case numbers mean that what we are doing is working. More information about case numbers can be found on our website.

COVID-19 Vaccine Update

Nearly 100,000 doses of the vaccine have been given in the area. Local statistics show that over 77% of people aged 18 years and older have been vaccinated with at least one dose in the NWHU region, while over 60% of the area's adults have received their second dose.

Our large-scale immunization clinics will wrap up by the end of July as they are no longer filling up. Once they are over, we will provide the vaccine in our offices and at smaller clinics in the community. The clinics that we have planned are listed on our [webpage](#). Eligible groups to get the vaccine include:

Dose 1: Anyone aged 12 years or older.

Dose 2: Anyone aged 12+ who had their first dose of Pfizer at least 21 days ago or Moderna 28 days ago. Anyone who had AstraZeneca as a first dose at least 56 days (8 weeks) ago.
