New or activated TB Case Pathway

A team approach

Health care provider (HCP) identifies a suspect or confirmed TB case related to symptoms and history or lab confirmation.

HCP notifies NWHU (options: print then fill and fax form, or use fillable pdf then print and fax, or complete online).

Health care provider role:

- Medical assessment and monitoring
- Orders diagnostics
- Prescribes medication for the duration of treatment

NWHU role:

- Help HCP connect with ID Specialist
- Set up translation services, if needed
- Connect HCP with TB care guidance
- Report case and details to Ministry of Health
- Provide free medication and monitoring of medication compliance and side effects
- Communicate with HCP and ID Specialist as needed

ID Specialist advises HCP on diagnostics, medication, medical aspects of patient care.
