

Green Door Project

The Green Door Project (GDP) is a partnership between Northwestern Health Unit (NWHU) and Green Shield Canada that provides free emergency dental services to eligible adults aged 18-64. NWHU can help you complete application forms and find a dental provider.

Eligibility Requirements

- Resident of NWHU region aged 18-64
- Have an urgent dental concern
- Have no other dental benefits through private insurance or other government program
- Unable to pay for dental services

Services Covered

- Exam
- X-rays
- Tooth repairs and removals
- Treatment for infection and pain

Other services may be considered on a case-by case basis.

Applying to the Program

- Download and print the application from NWHU's website; or
- Call the NWHU dental team; or
- Visit any NWHU office to pick up a paper copy of the application.
- Completed applications can be dropped off, mailed, faxed, or emailed to NWHU.

Approval

Applicants will receive a phone call or letter letting them know if they have been approved for enrollment, and how to access care.

Coverage Period

Once enrolled, services must be completed within six months.

Service Locations

NWHU will help clients to find a dental provider at either a private office, NWHU community clinic, or the Mobile Dental Office (MDO).
