Progressive Enforcement Process

1st Offence

- · Education provided by school staff
- Confiscation of contraband by school staff (if internal policy allows)

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- Confiscation of contraband by school staff (if internal policy allows)
- 2nd Offence •2nd offence written warning letter sent home to parents/guardians by school staff

3rd Offence

- 3rd offence written warning letter sent home to parents/guardians by school staff
- NWHU notice of 3rd offence referall form and witness statement form sent to NWHU by school staff
- Meeting set up with individual, parent/guardian (optional), school staff and NWHU tobacco enforcement officer to determine next steps
- If charges are laid, NWHU to confiscate contraband material
